Before You Begin:

NOTE: Two person assembly is required.

Assembly Preparation:

- · Open and remove contents from all boxes
- · Check all parts against the parts list
- Organize parts by type
- · Locate a clear, level floor
- Lay the shipping carton cardboard on the floor and assemble the unit on it to protect unit from floor damage during assembly.

Tools Required:

- Rubber Mallet
- 3/8", 7/16", and 9/16" sockets with ratchet
- 1/4" and 5/32" Hex Allen Wrench











Assembly


*Indicates steps involving optional door assembly

- 1) Assemble start tube and base hardware
- 2) Mount side panels to base
- 3) Install back panels (*install Tops and threaded rods*)
- 4) Install start tubes

- 5) Fasten side panel to base
- 6) Install casters or floor mounting options
- 7) Shelf and apparel hook installation
- 8) *Door installation*

1) Assemble Start Tube and Base


Step 1a: Locate the following items: start tube (can be a 2-start or 3-start depending on your order), wedge nuts, 1/4-20 x 5-1/2" bolts, 1/4" flat washers. Install the bolt with the washers through each start tube into the U-channels and thread on the wedge nuts as shown. **WEDGE NUTS MUST BE ORIENTED AS SHOWN. Do not tighten bolts at this time.** Follow the same procedure for the base.





2) Assemble Side Panels to Base

Step 2a: position base as shown below.



Step 2b: Position a side panel so the hole on the bottom of the round tube is located at the base. Slide the side panel over the U-channels as shown. Do not slide the side panel all the way down on the base at this point. Ensure the side

panels short wires are facing right. The shelves will not fit properly if the sides are oriented incorrectly. Install the remaining sides per the instructions. * If you have ordered the door option see the illustration on Page 7 for side panel orientation. *


DETAIL A SCALE 1:4

When assembling a unit with the door options the side panels have an orientation that needs to be followed. The side panel on the left end side will have only a hasp mounted to it. The right end side panel will have only hinges mounted to it. Every side panel in the middle will have both hinges and a hasp mounted to them. See the diagram on Page 7.

* ORIENTATION OF SIDE PANELS WITH DOOR OPTION *

NOTE: As you face the unit from one side the short wires on the side panels will all be on the right side. As you face the unit from the other side all the short wires on the side panels will be on the left side.






3) Install Back Panels

Step 3a: Slide the side panels out enough to allow the back panel to be placed into position. The extended wires on the back panels will mate into the holes on the side panel square tubes. Place all panels into position with the GearGrid logo at the top.

* If you have ordered the door option, install the tops now. For this step, use the same process as the Back Panel Installation. Next, install the threaded rod through all tops and side panels then thread on the two castle nuts.






Step 3b: Once the side and back panels are in position it is now time to seat those components all the way down on top of the base.

4) Install the Start Tube

Step 4a: : locate the start tube with the assembled hardware. Slide the start tubes U-channels into the top of the side panels as shown in the diagram below. Tighten the bolts, do not over tighten.



5) Fasten the Side Panels to the Base

Step 5a: Install the #14 sheet metal screws up through the bottom of the base and into the bottom of each side. Tighten these screws.


6) Install Casters or Floor Mounting Options

Step 6a: Install the casters into the base legs and install the $1/4-20 \times 3/8$ " set screws into the back of the base legs. Ensure the casters are pressed all the way up when tightening the set screws. Tip fully assembled base unit up onto its casters.


7) Shelf and Apparel Hook Installation

Step 7a: Install the shelves into the unit as shown in the diagrams on Page 9. The hooks on the shelves get placed over the horizontal wires on the side panels. The left side hook will be placed behind the first vertical side panel wire. The right side shelf hook will get placed in front of the first vertical wire.






Step 7b: Install the apparel hooks as shown in the diagram below.






8) *Optional Door Installation

Step 8a: Install the brass bushings on all hinges located on the side panels as shown below.



Step 8b: Install doors over the hinges as shown below.





Step 8c: Install the door hasps finger tight using the supplied 1/4-20 x 3/8" button head screws as shown below. Close the door to align the position of the hasps and then tighten the screws with an Allen wrench.
